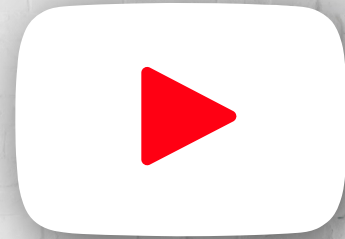

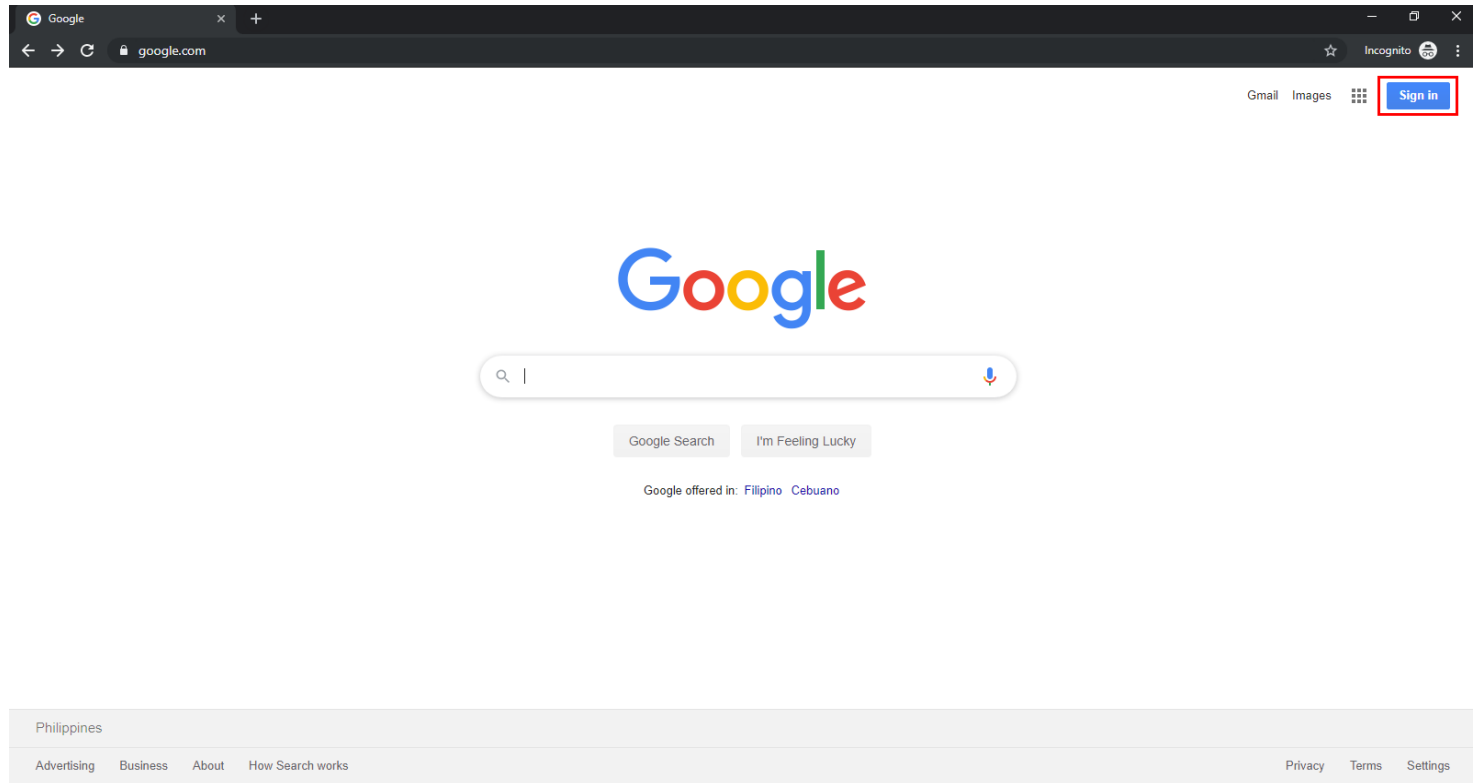

Creating Your Account

Before you can log in to youtube, make sure you secure a gmail account first for you to use as the log in account for youtube. If you already have a gmail account, then please skip STEPS 1 to 6 and proceed to STEP 7.

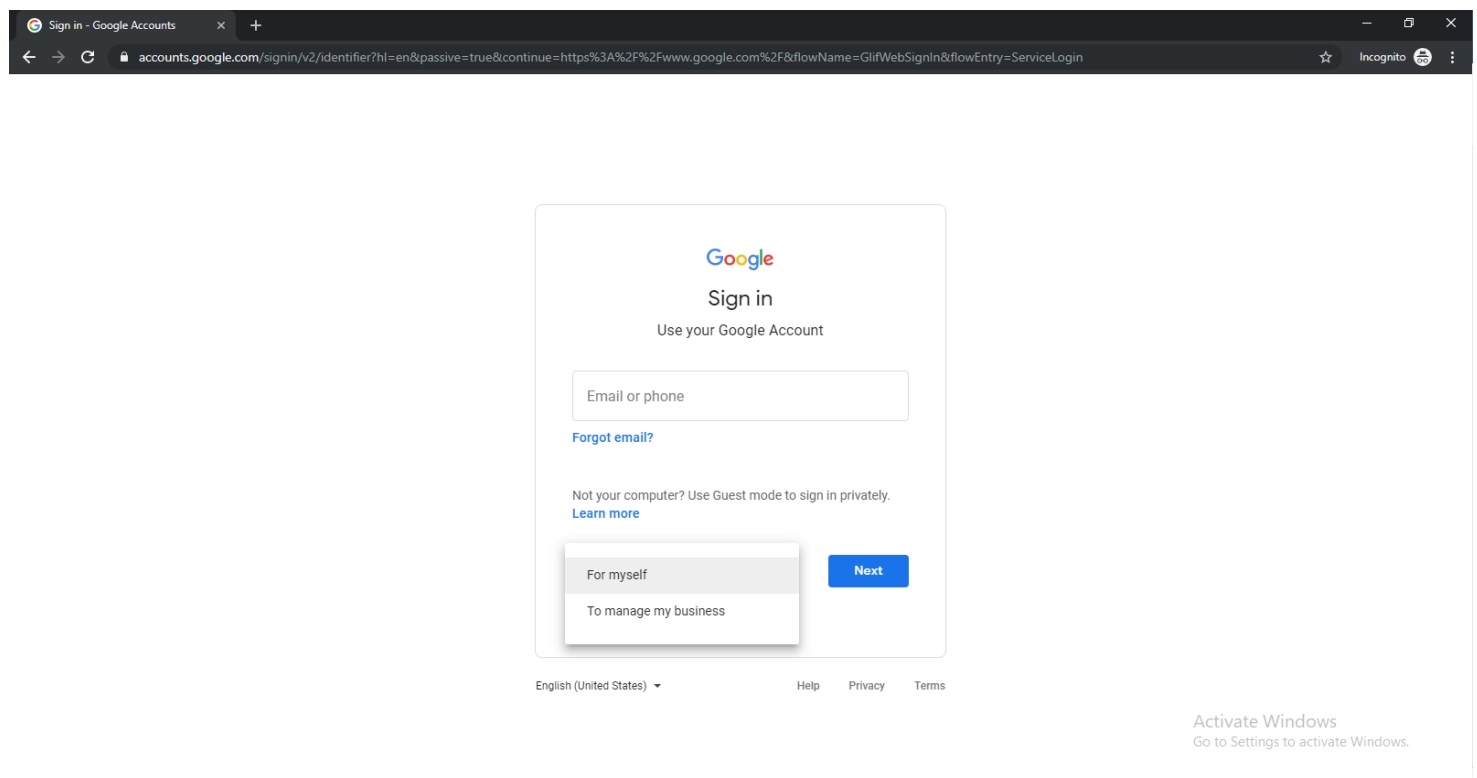
STEP 1

Go to google.com and click on "Sign in" button on the top right corner.



STEP 2

Then click on "Create account" and choose what suits your needs.

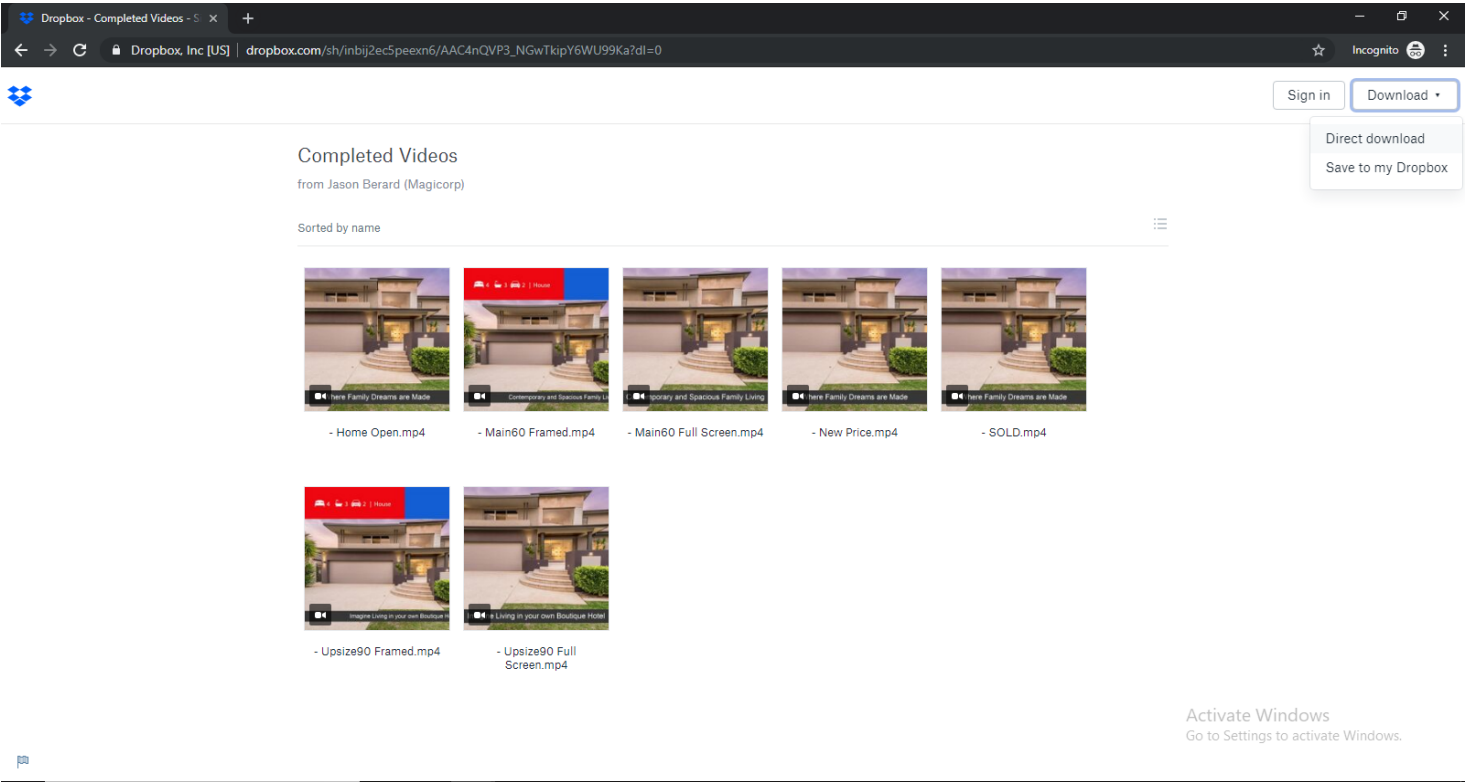

Downloading Videos from Dropbox link

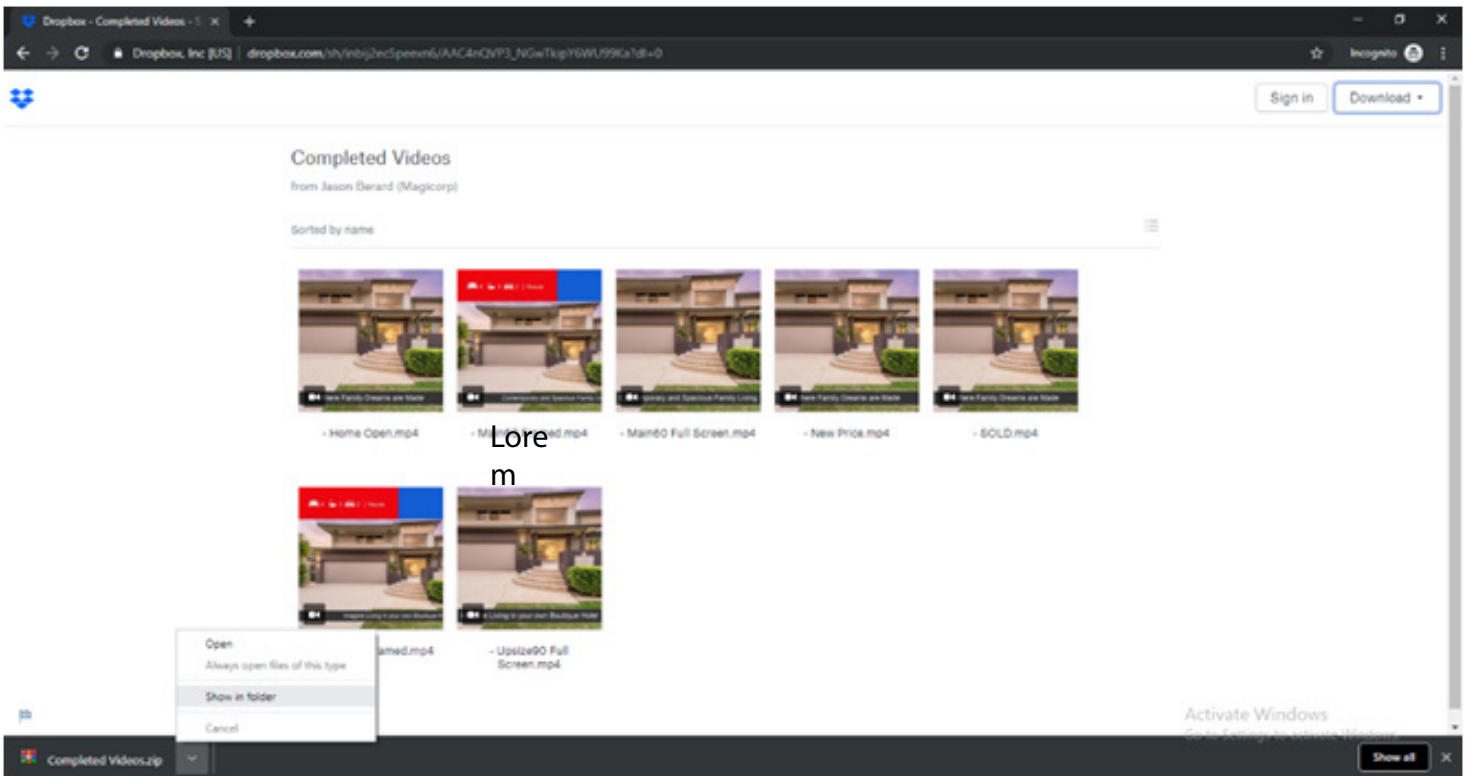
STEP 1

Click the dropbox link provided on REvid email to see the available videos. Once you're on the link, click on the dropdown download button then direct download on the top right corner to get all file.



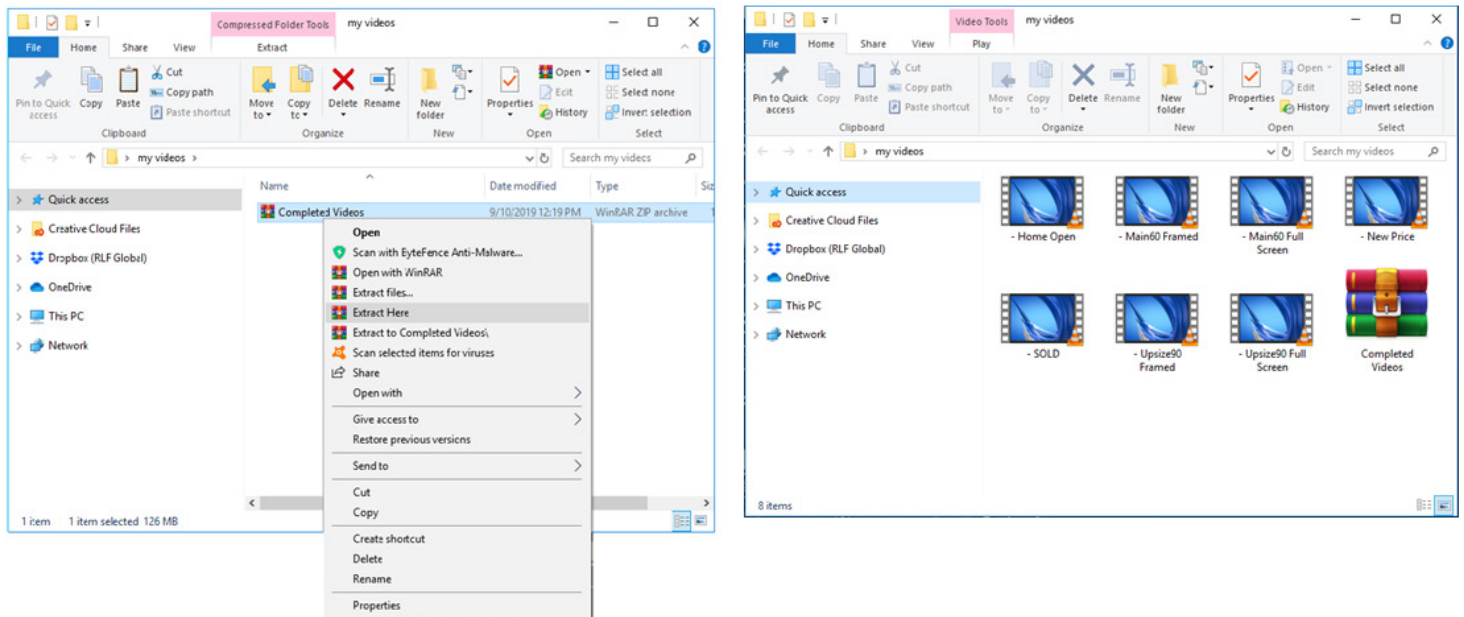
STEP 2

Once the download is complete, you will see a zip folder on the bottom left corner of the browser. Click on the arrow and choose "show in folder" to locate the file. (If you can't see the downloaded folder on the bottom part, check on your "Downloads" folder on local drive).



STEP 3

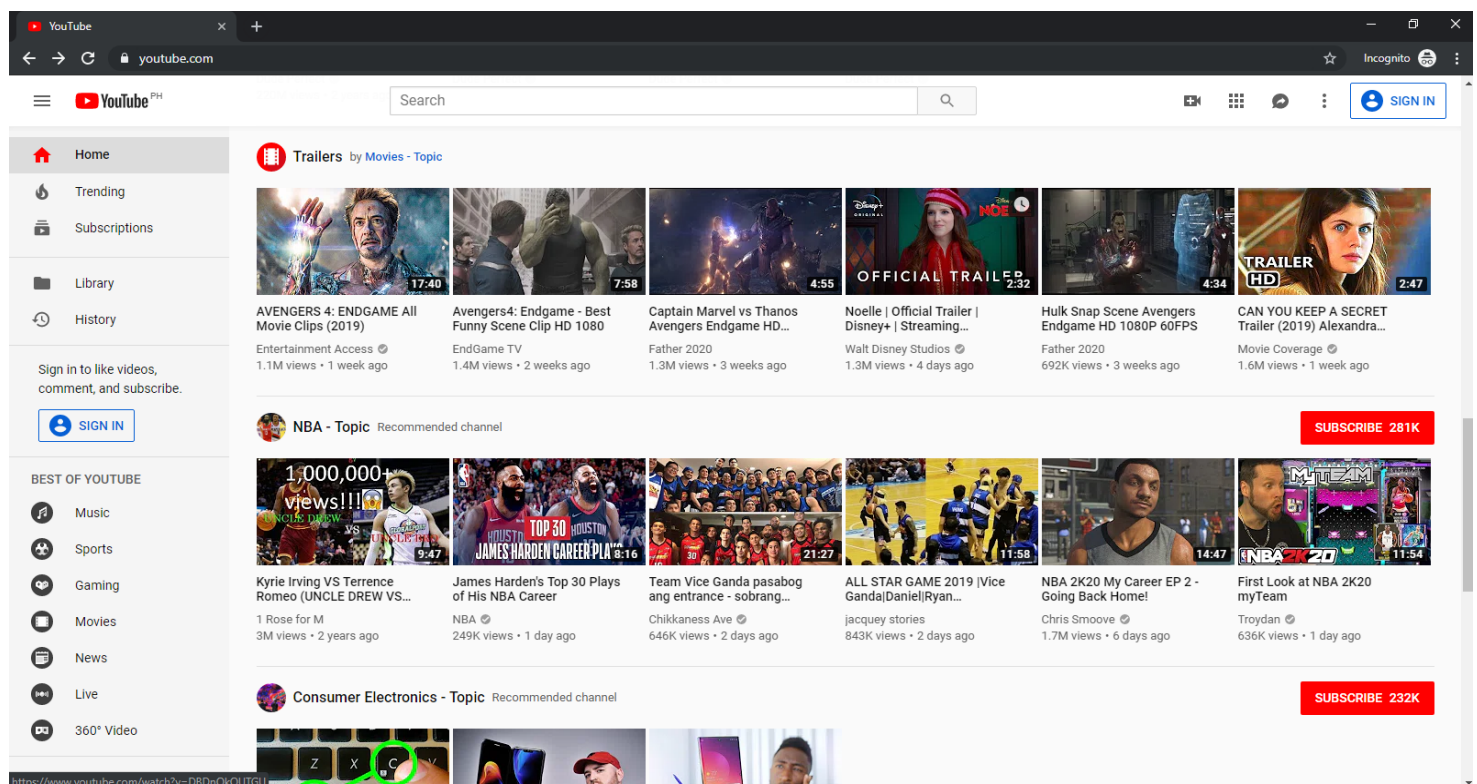
Place the zip folder on the location where you want to extract it. Right Click on the zip folder and choose "Extract Here". After extracting, downloading is now complete and you can now watch your videos and upload it on your social media.



Posting Your Video

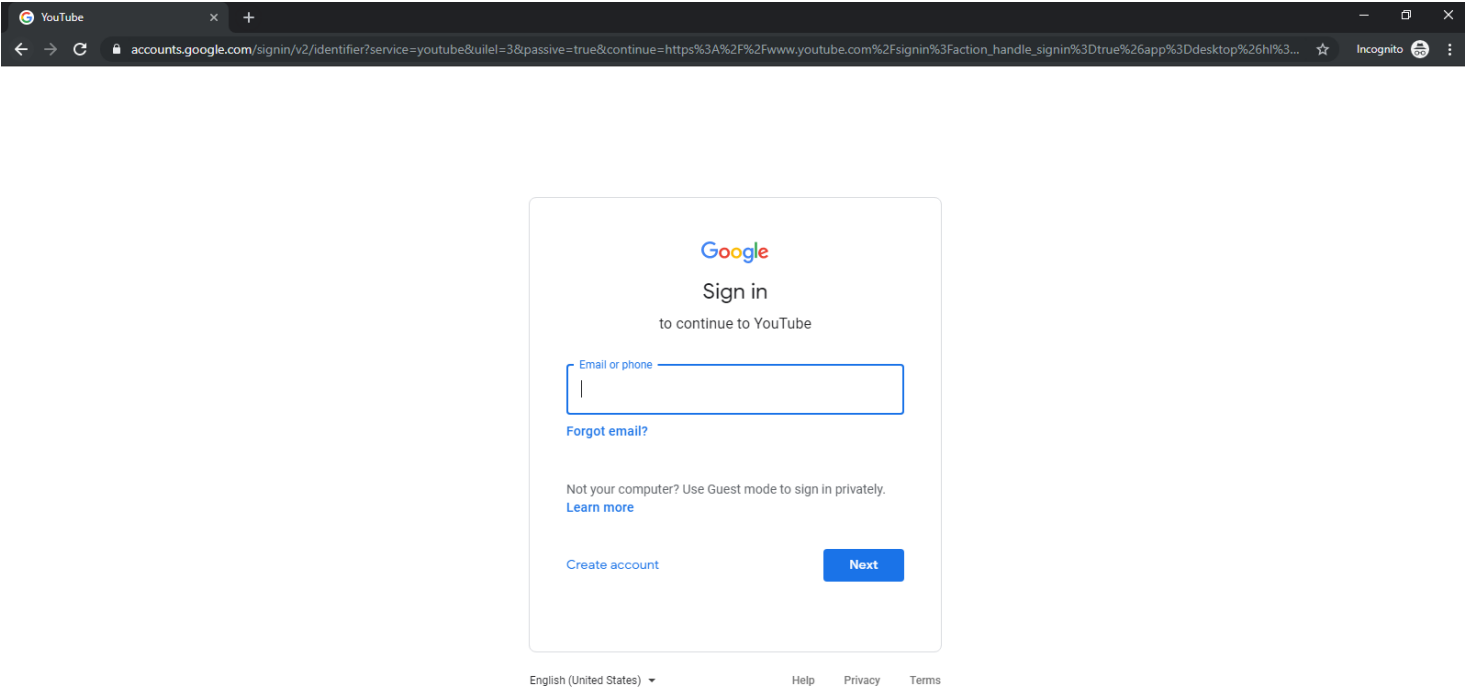
STEP 1

Go to youtube.com and click on "sign in" on the top right side of the screen.



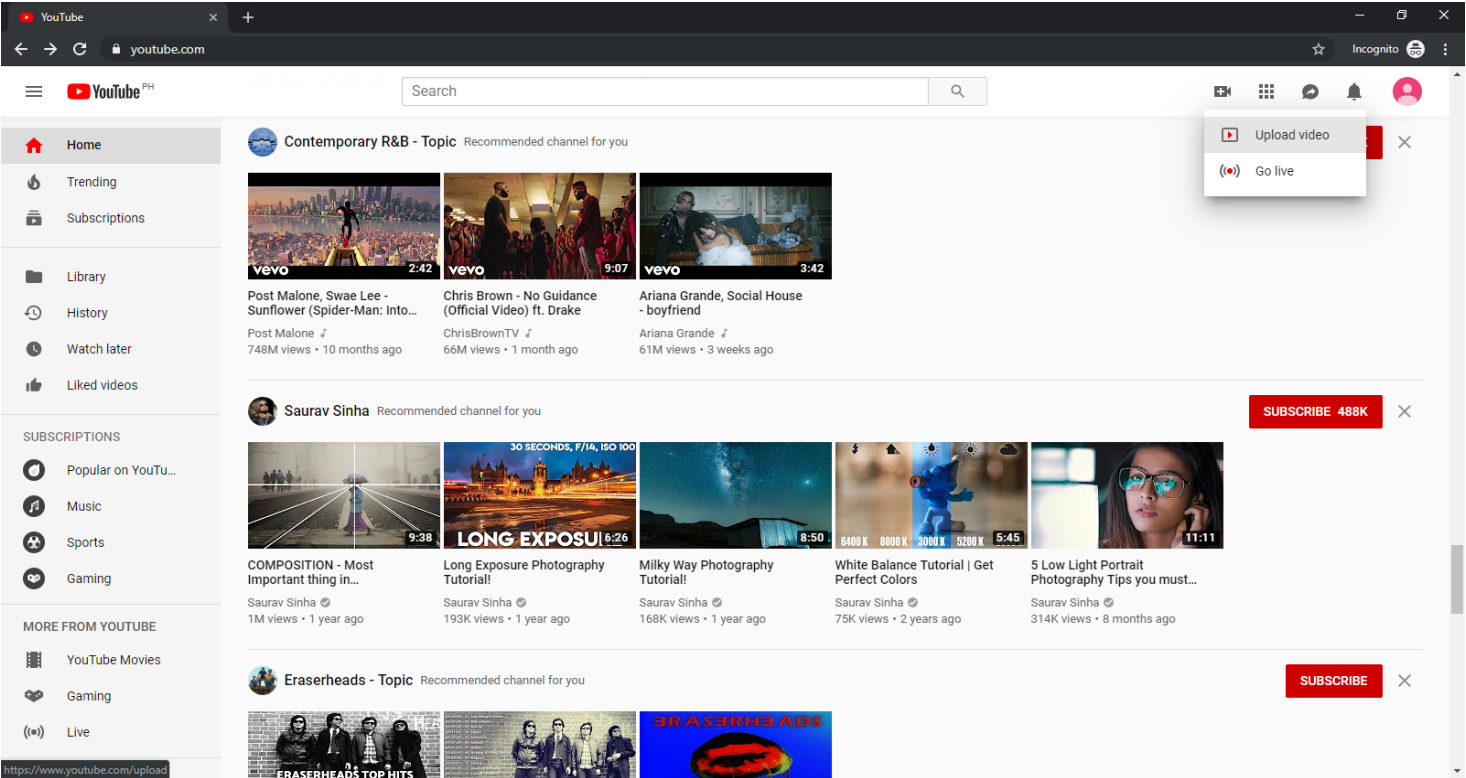
STEP 2

Type the Log in details of your gmail account.



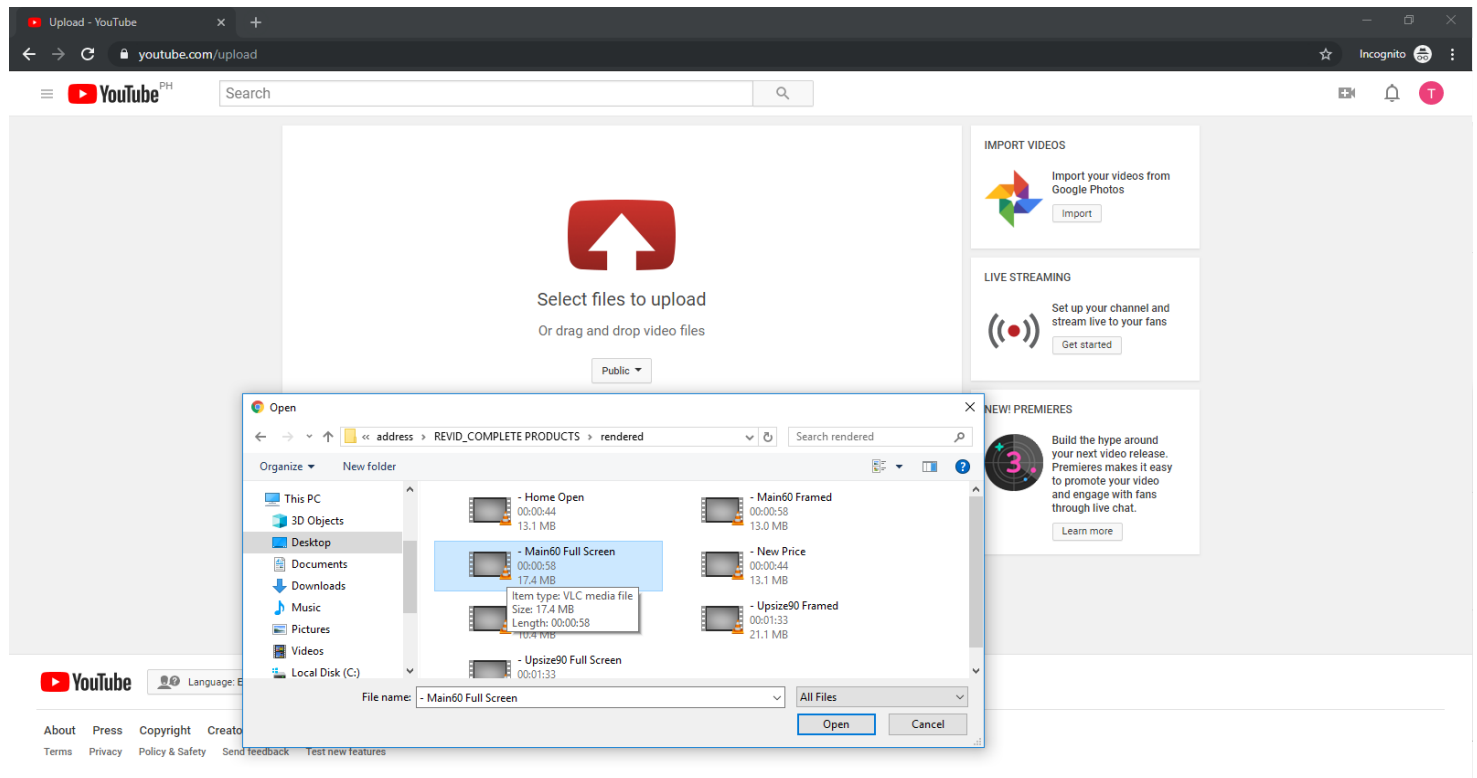
STEP 3

Click the "create video or post" icon on the top right side of the screen. Then click "upload video".



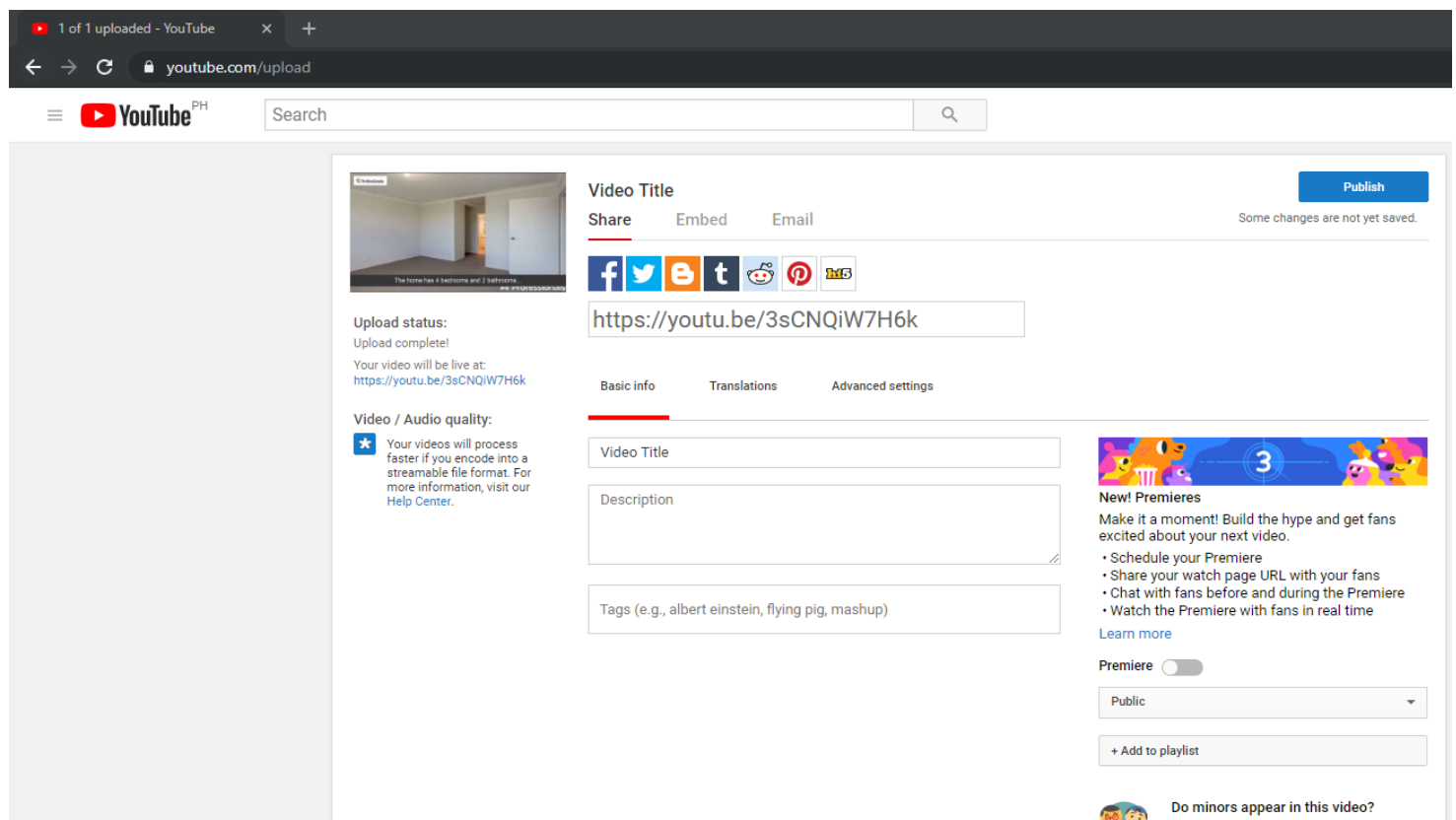
STEP 4

Select the video or drag and drop the file you want to upload on youtube.



STEP 5

Place the information you want to show while waiting for the video to finish uploading. Such as; Title, Descriptions and Thumbnail. You may also add tags below the description/caption to amplify your audience and to have more engagement to your video. (e.g. #revidvideo .This will make it possible for others to easily find your video with a specific theme or content that you placed on your hashtags).



STEP 6

Click on "publish" or "done" once you placed all the necessary details.

Customizing your Youtube Channel

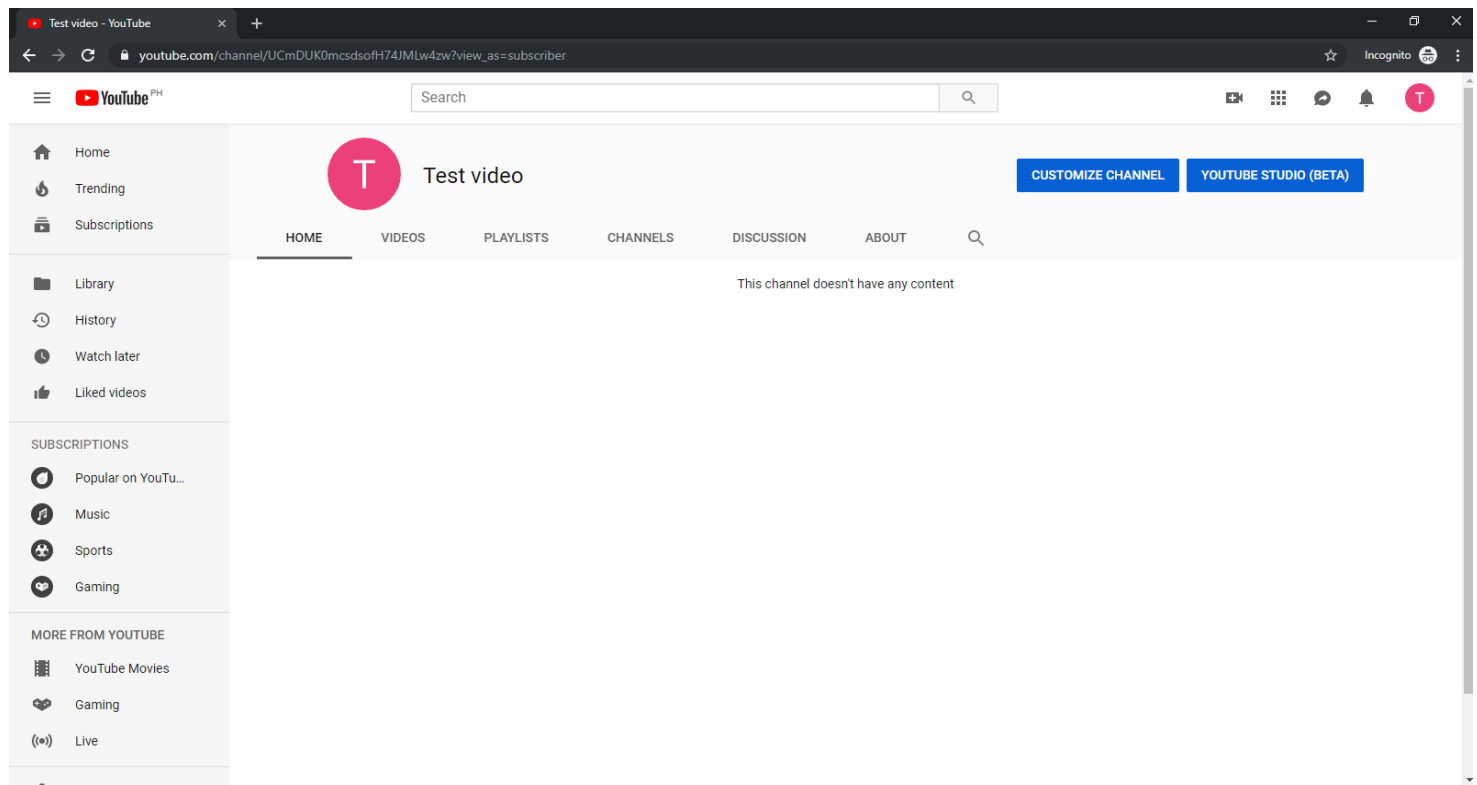
STEP 1

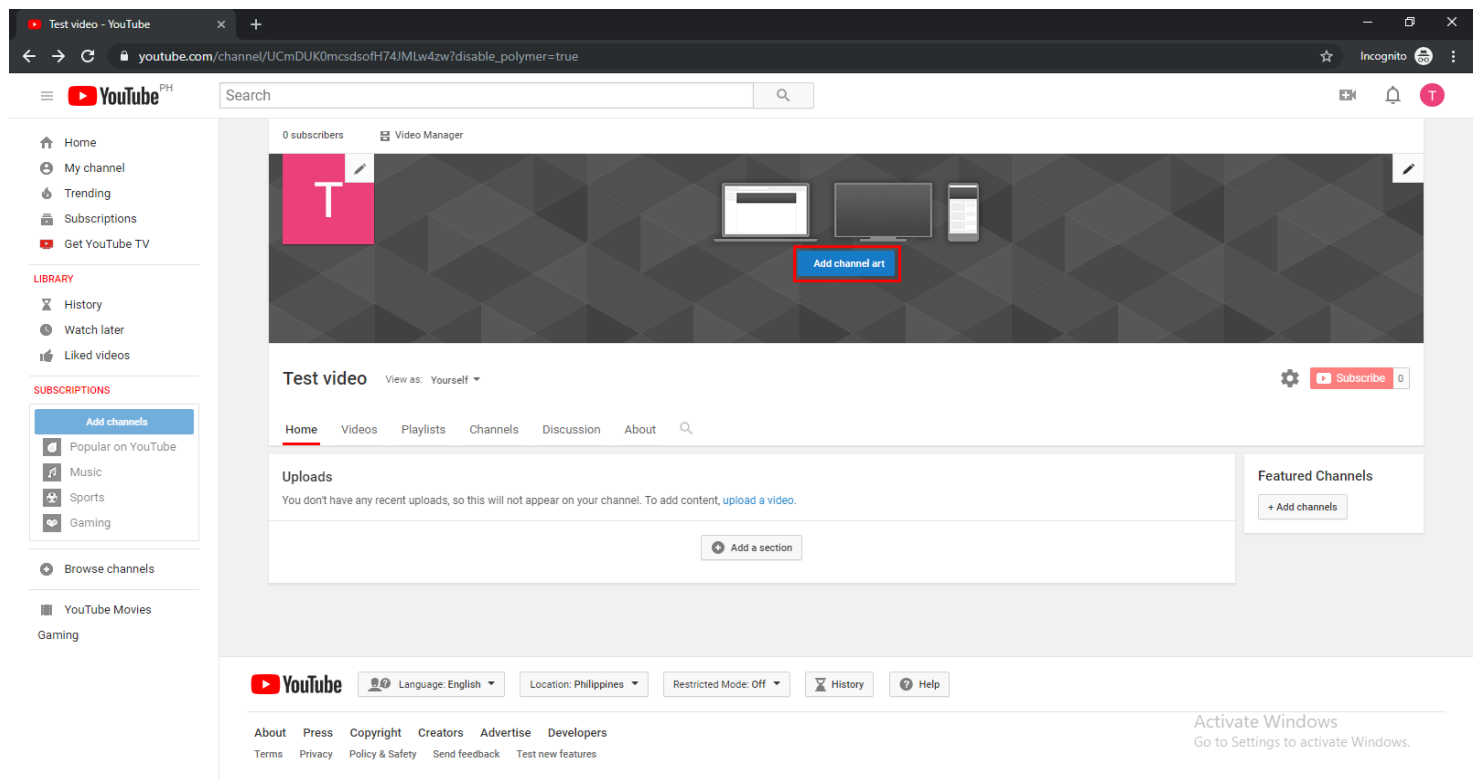
STEP 2

Click on "Customize Channel".



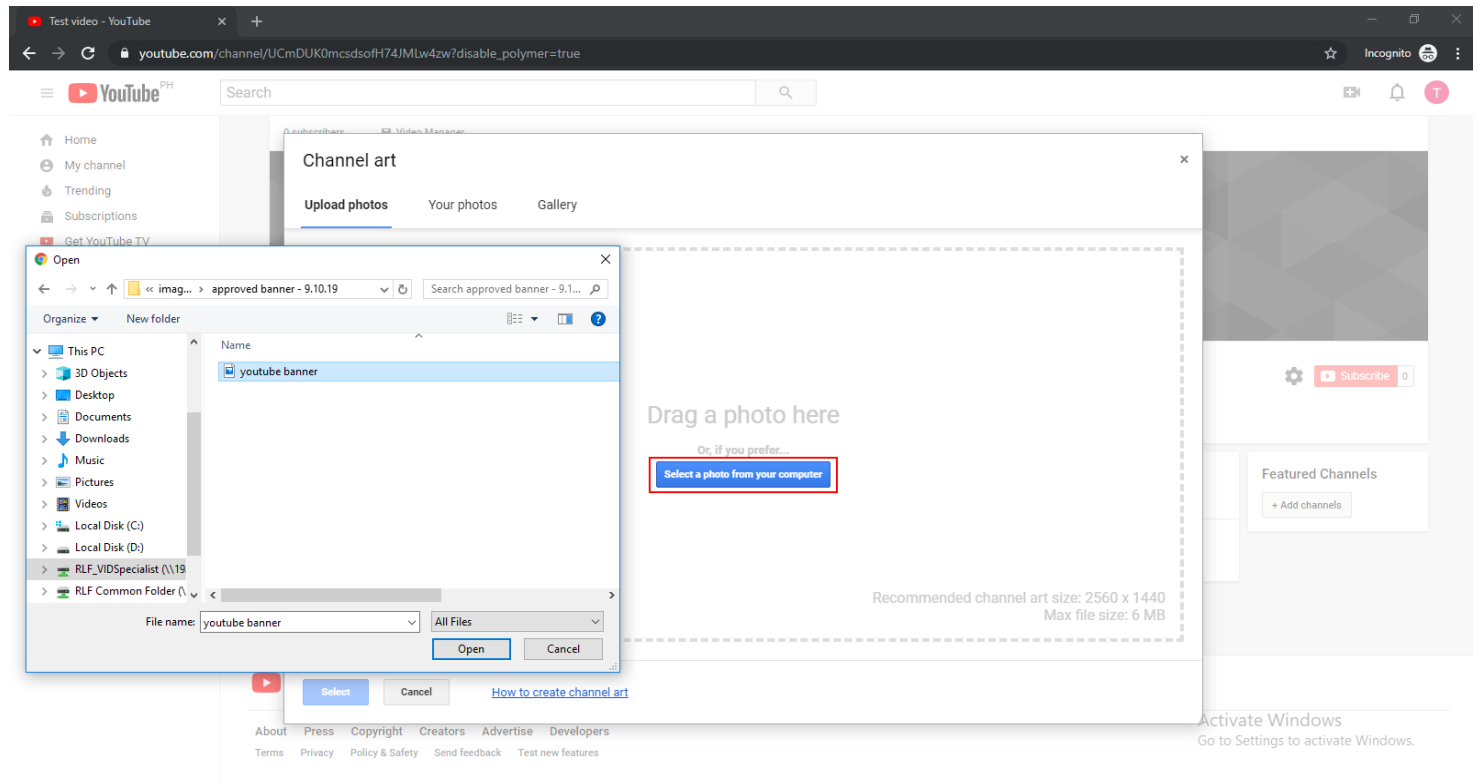
STEP 3

Click on "Add channel Art" to add banner image or the gray pencil icon on the right side corner to edit links or channel art.



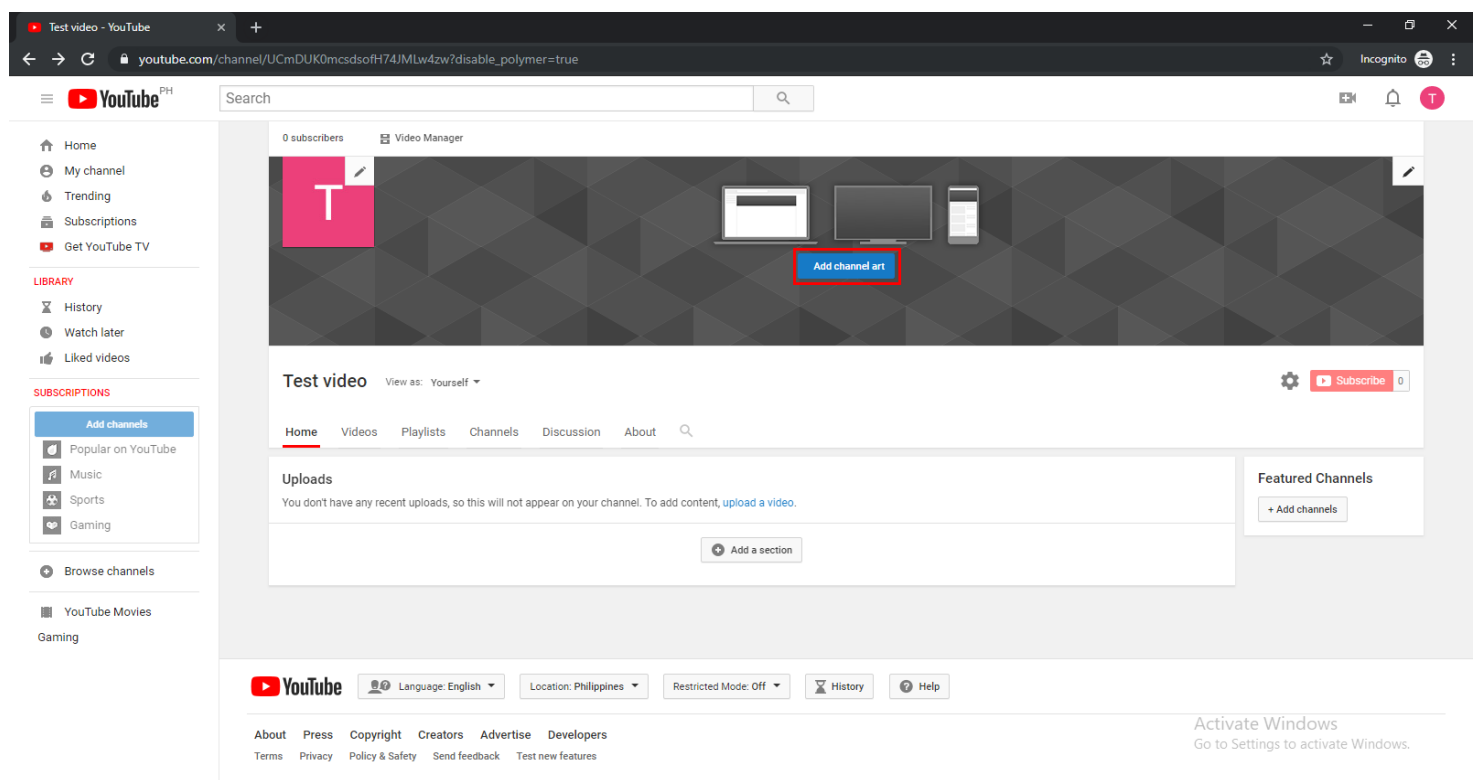
STEP 4

Upload an image or photo from your computer or saved photos. You can also click the Gallery tab to choose an image from the YouTube photo library. (Recommended channel art size: 2560 pixels wide by x 1440 pixels tall and Maximum file size is 6 MB).



STEP 5

Click on the gray pencil icon to add or edit your "Channel icon". Please note that your channel icon comes from your google account. We recommend using a corporate image or your company logo (Recommended channel icon size: 800 x 800 pixels).



STEP 6

Click on "About" to put or edit your "Channel Description", "Email", "Location" and "Links".
